TOLEDO'S ZIN STRING QUARTET AND POET KATE LIGHT PRESENT "EINSTEIN'S MOZART" AS CHAMBER MUSIC TOLEDO'S 2007-2008 ARTIST SERIES CONTINUES

The Zin String Quartet and poet Kate Light continue Chamber Music Toledo's 2007-2008 Artist Series with a concert performance of "EINSTEIN'S MOZART," Sunday January 6th at 3:00 p.m. at the Maumee Indoor Theater, 601 Conant Street in uptown Maumee, Ohio.

This new work with original poetry by Kate Light and music by Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart celebrates and commemorates the convergence of the centenary of Einstein's Miracle Year (1905-2005) and Mozart's 250th birthday (1756-2006).

The Toledo-based ZIN STRING QUARTET was first established under the umbrella of the New Renaissance Ensemble, a group founded of Toledo Symphony Orchestra members to perform early music on modern instruments, but with historical principals and practices. They perform quartets, trios, duos, and solos from the early Renaissance to the still-being-written.

KATE LIGHT is the author of three volumes of poetry, Gravity's Dream (Donald Justice Award), Open Slowly, and The Laws of Falling Bodies (Nicholas Roerich Prize), and the texts of Oceanophony and Einstein's Mozart. She is also a professional violinist in New York City. "It's hard to think of a poet so aptly named as Kate Light, except, of course, for Wordsworth. The step of her poems is light, and plenty of that luminous stuff is shed here." - Billy Collins
